


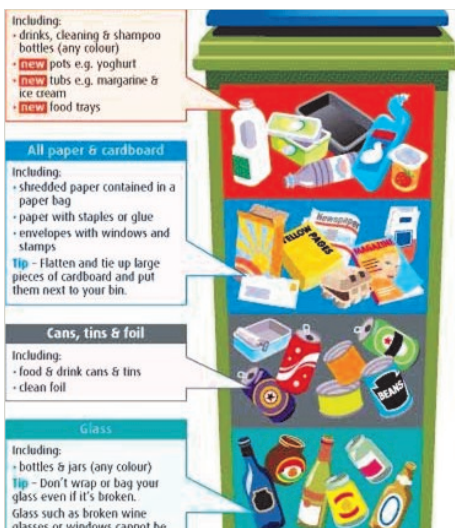

RECYCLING UPDATE



Elmbridge BC have announced that you are now able to recycle all of your plastics pots, tubs and trays in your blue top bin. You can now recycle items such as yoghurt pots, margarine and ice cream tubs, food trays (including meat trays) and even plastic bottle lids.

Once collected, the plastic containers will be taken to a reprocessor and recycled to make clothing such as fleeces, and furnishings like carpets and curtains. They'll also be used to manufacture construction materials as well as being recycled back into plastic bottles.

The result of this is that Elmbridge will recycle more than it throws away.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE HILL

Well the summer is here and I hope you've all got exciting plans whether you're staying local or roaming further afield.

We've had some recent changes to our road maintenance contract and this should deliver an improved service to us. In the first month of the contract almost 270,000 square meters of road were resurfaced.

Key changes from the contract are:

- Potholes are due to have an assessment and temporary patch made within 24hrs
- Permanent repair made within 24hrs to 28 days

Old Avenue / Gower Road Junction

I understand that there have been calls for a 4-way stop at this junction. I have discussed this with Surrey County Council (SCC), and sadly this is not an approved road marking in the UK. I will continue to monitor the situation, and please contact me if you have any concerns or thoughts on this.



St. George's Avenue

At SCC's Local Committee Meeting (November), they will discuss parking restrictions and this will then be open for public consultation. Resurfacing the road will be reviewed for the 2012/13 budget. Once I have further information I will update you.

Ellesmere Road

We've finally got confirmation that the lines will be on the ground in early autumn after further discussion with local residents

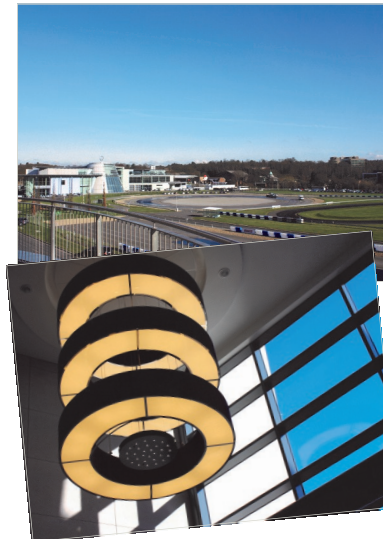

To get you in the mood for some of these events, why not try one of these delicious drinks at your next summer party or BBQ:

BBC (Baileys Banana Colada) - serves 4

In a blender, combine 2 bananas and 6fl oz banana liqueur; blend until smooth. Blend in 6fl oz of Irish cream and 6fl oz coconut cream (room temp). Finally, add 6 cups of crushed ice and blend until smooth.

Caribbean Cream—serves 4

Put the flesh of 1 mango into a liquidiser, add 400g of pineapple, juice of 1/2 lime, 1 chopped banana, and 150ml semi-skimmed milk. Blend until smooth and creamy
