1 Investing in your community

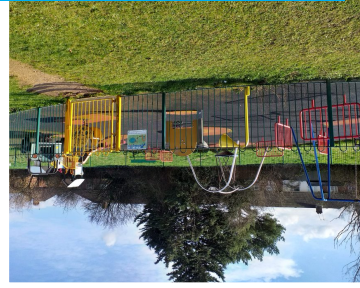

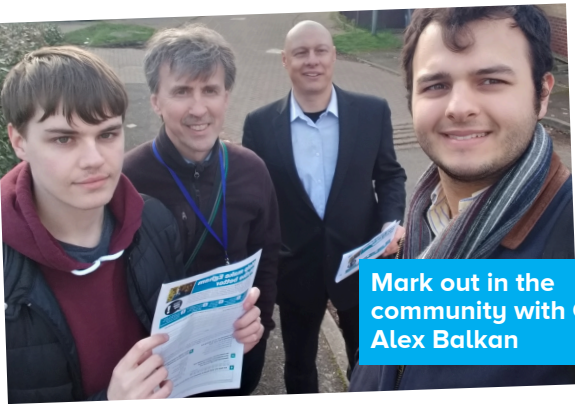
